The Office of the Dean of Student Life resolves allegations that a student has violated the Code of Student Conduct and Responsibility (the Code).

The Office of the Dean of Student Life has received a complaint that alleges that you have violated the following sections of the Code:

Obstruction or Disruption of University Activity or Process: 577-031-0135 (1)
Obstruction or disruption of teaching, research, administration, disciplinary procedures or other University activities, including the University's public service functions or other authorized activities on University-owned or -controlled property.

Failure to Comply: 577-031-0136 (16) Failure to comply with a University Official's requests. Students and Recognized Student Organizations and groups are expected to comply with and respond appropriately to the lawful requests of University Officials made in the performance of their duties.

Specifically, during an incident on **March 16, 2011**, you are alleged to have engaged in the following behavior:

disrupting University processes by engaging in consistently disruptive behavior toward University staff members.

A hearing has been scheduled to review this incident. Our office seeks to have all of the information before we make a conduct decision, and this hearing is your opportunity to present any relevant material related to this incident for consideration.

You must have your PSU Student ID with you to check in for your meeting. You will be asked to retrieve it if you do not have it with you. Failure to produce your Student ID Card may result in your forfeiture of your right to attend the meeting.

The purpose of this hearing is to determine whether there are reasonable grounds to believe the complaint is well-founded. If it is found that there are not reasonable grounds to adjudicate this complaint, the matter may be referred to mediation or dismissed. If it determined there are reasonable grounds to adjudicate the complaint, you will then be assigned to a hearing body.

Please notify our office and contact the Disability Resource Center ([503-725-4150](tel:503-725-4150)) to arrange for any necessary accommodations. Failure to appear for this investigatory meeting will not halt conduct proceedings.

Should you fail to attend the hearing, the hearing body will review the information received, decide the level of your responsibility, and determine if a sanction is appropriate. If you are found responsible for violating the Code, a fee will be charged to your student account and additional sanctions may be imposed. For details about potential fees and sanctions, please see sections 577-031-0144 and 577-031-0145 of the Code.
