

additional disciplinary action. The Chief Academic Officer will initiate the hearing process.

4. **Flagrant Act:** For flagrant acts of plagiarism where the intent to plagiarize is clear, such as turning in another student's work as one's own or copying significant portions of published material without documenting sources, the faculty member may assign a grade of "0" on the work and request that the case proceed immediately to the Academic Standards Board for disciplinary action.

5. If a student disagrees with the instructor's judgment, see "Academic Grievances in Part I.

Advertising, Sales, Solicitation and Fund Raising Policy

Advertising is defined as the posting, distribution or display of any material or information or the use of public address systems on the MUW campus. All off-campus individuals or entities desiring to advertise or place exhibits on campus or to recruit students must request written permission from the Office of the Vice President for Student Services.

Posters, banners, signs or circulars displayed on campus must bear the name of the sponsoring organization. Persons responsible for individual buildings may determine where advertisements may be placed in the building. Advertisements are not to be placed on painted walls. Banners may be hung only in designated areas on campus.

The on-campus distribution of handbills or circulars on cars or car windshields will not be permitted without written permission from the Office of the Vice President for Student Services. Any form of advertising or solicitation that obstructs traffic entering or leaving university buildings is prohibited.

The campus mail system is not to be used for personal or commercial solicitation or advertisement. Advertisement, through the campus mail system, of approved activities or fund-raising events conducted by administrative units and student organizations is permitted.

Social organizations have a designated bulletin board reserved exclusively for their use. Only social organization information is allowed on this board. Social organizations are allowed to post on this board without the Office of Student Life's approval, as long as it pertains to social club information.
