

Memorial Lawn Displays

The University respects the right of all members of the SMU community to express their opinions. The University also respects the right of all members of the community to avoid messages that are triggering, harmful, or harassing. It is the policy of the University to protect the exercise of these rights. These rights come with the responsibility not to abuse or violate civil and property rights of others, or to interfere in the conduct of University business.

Definition of Memorial Lawn Display

A memorial lawn display is any type of visual recognition or commemoration of an event or political or social issue. Examples of items used in the display include, but are not limited to: crosses, flags, etc.

Guidelines for Lawn Displays

1. Lawn displays are restricted to MoMac Park (at the intersection of Airline and Bishop Blvd);
2. Space can be reserved for up to five (5) days using the Outdoor Event Request Form;
3. Display items (including any accompanying text or artwork) must be approved by Student Activities prior to being placed on the grounds;
4. Display items must be removed by sponsoring organization on the last day of the reservation.
